King-like discretionary powers

We're calling for clear, objective tests to guide decisions, and the removal of excessive ministerial powers





Deforestation loopholes

Close the logging loopholes, repeal the ‘continuation of use’ exemption, and make national standards truly enforceable across all deforestation and land clearing.

Climate damage gap

Make climate central to the law's purpose, require full emissions disclosure, and close loopholes for major polluters and offshore gas projects.





Offloading Federal responsibility

The federal government must retain responsibility for Matters of National Environmental Significance and hold states to enforceable standards.

Pay-to-destroy scheme

Remove the pay-to-destroy offsets fund, ensure all offsets deliver real outcomes for nature, and build transparency directly into the legislation.
